



Volleyball Rules

1. Championship Programme

Day 1: arrival of the teams, technical meeting and ID-Check*

Day 2: competitions

Day 3: competitions

Day 4: competitions and excursion

Day 5: competitions

Day 6: competitions, technical meeting and closing ceremony

Day 7: departure of the teams

*Necessary documents from the Head of Delegation for the ID-Check: Signed form "Declaration of Participation" and personal legitimation from the participants.

The opening ceremony will be held either on day 1 or day 2.

The excursion will be no more than half a day and will be held at the discretion of the organisers during the USIC championships.

2. Composition of the Delegations

Each delegation will consist of a maximum number of 15 (16) participants:

Physio, Masseur **	1
Head of Delegation	<u>1</u>
Participants	15
Interpreter *	1

* *for delegations who speak no English (only if required)*

** *it is left up to the delegation to arrive with a Masseur, Physio*

4. Balls

5. Drawing of Lots and Tournament Schedule

The principles of the drawing of lots and the tournament schedule are described in the Sport Regulations and its annex. Matches are played according to the best-of-five principle.

6. Ranking

If two or more teams/countries have the same number of points, the following system shall be used:

1. The result of a mutual match
2. Higher set ratio
3. Higher ball ratio
4. Fair play ranking
5. Decision by draw
